1. CALL TO ORDER

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS: ***Ordinance 2022-02 Tax Levy in the amount of \$794,200***

To ensure the public's full understanding of the Tax Levy the Library Director and Library Board made the following statement:

The Riverdale Public Library District has proposed a tax levy increase for 2022. The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$794,200 which represents a 9.0% increase over the previous year. The reason for this increase is to ensure library funding remains at a stable level in the event of an EAV decrease and to rectify previous years deficient levy proposals by now levying for the correct amount to support the library.
